Field Excursions

Symposium Program includes 2 field excursions.

Tour 1 – Get-to-know bus tour to the forests of Izhemskoe Lesnitchestvo (50 km north from Arkhangelsk City). Tour time is 1 day (September, 8). It includes acquaintance with demonstration objects and lunch. Returning to Arkhangelsk at latest 7 p.m. Tour costs (including transfer and lunch) – 22 euro.

Tour 2 - Excursion on forest and tundra landscapes, and historic places of Solovki archipelago. Tour time is 2 days (September, 8-9). Departure to Solovki and return to Arkhangelsk is by charter flight. Approximate time of return is 5 p.m. to Vas’kovo airport. There will be transfer to Talagi airport or to the railway station. Approximate tour costs — 500 euro, it includes air tickets, accommodation, visiting B. Zayatskiy Island with three northern taiga landscapes (northern taiga, pre-tundra and tundra).

Tour payment – on arrival to the symposium.

Symposium Program includes visiting of the Museum of Wooden Architecture «Malye Karely» which is situated in 30 km from Arkhangelsk.
